MEN'S JUNIOR CUP ALL IRELAND FINALS



Dundalk will face County Sligo Golf Club in the All-Ireland quarter-final of the Men's Junior Cup on Saturday fortnight, September 17. The tie consists of five singles matches with the first teeing off at 12.45pm.

Joint managers Conor Curran and Ronan Farrelly are hoping that as many members as possible will make their way to Knightsbrook Golf Club in Trim for the quarter-final and, hopefully, the semi-final and final which will take place the next day, Sunday, September 18.

Recent appearances in the All-Ireland finals of the Junior Cup, Barton Shield and Jimmy Bruen Shield saw big numbers of members wearing their club colours turn up and was much appreciated by the players and managers of the teams involved. With the club having only won one All-Ireland title in its history, it is important that we all play our part to bring a second green pennant back to Dundalk by turning up in Knightsbrook and ensuring there is a sea of blue on the first tee.

To facilitate members wishing to travel to Trim on Saturday fortnight there will be a free bus to and from Knightsbrook which has been kindly sponsored by Declan Muckian of the Neptune Bar, Blackrock. The coach will depart Dundalk Golf Club at 11am and leave Knightsbrook immediately after the conclusion of the quarter-final which will be around 6pm.

If successful, the team will play in the All-Ireland Semi-Final on Sunday morning, September 18 at 8am with the final taking place that afternoon at 2pm.

A top-class field has entered the 36 hole tournament which will see each round commence with shotgun starts at 9am and 2pm.

Members are invited to attend the event and avail of the opportunity to see some of the top amateur golfers in Ireland in action as well as cheering on the strong Dundalk contingent in the field.
